During this workshop you will learn about Eyes on the Forest (EOTF), a great program that allows you to monitor your trees and provide useful information for the protection of our trees in forests, backyards, and other areas! The overall aim is for residents of Michigan to learn more about the risks and impacts of invasive forest pests by monitoring their own trees and forests. The indoor component will focus on learning about three target pests – Asian Longhorn Beetle (ALB), Hemlock Woolly Adelgid (HWA), and Thousand Cankers Disease (TCD), as well as the Midwest Invasive Species Information Network (MISIN; <http://www.misin.msu.edu/>), the online system used for reporting these three target pests or any other tree or forest health issue! In other words, EOTF is not just about ALB, HWA, and TCD; you can monitor any tree species for any pest! With more “Eyes on the Forest” we can all make a big difference in preventing the destruction of our natural resources due to invasive pests!
